

WEATHER EMERGENCY INFORMATION

When a Weather Emergency is declared, all streets in the Township are to be cleared during a weather emergency. Permanent Signs are posted in neighborhoods and on most streets entering developments. This does not mean there is a sign on every street in the Township, but that does not mean that street does not meet the requirements.

LMT uses WFMZ Storm Center to distribute weather emergency information which is available on WFMZ website, television. LMT also distributes weather emergency notifications on our website, Facebook, Twitter and our electronic information board in front of the township building.

*In addition, if you have not already done so, sign up thru our automated notification system to receive our mass email, phone or text messages in the event of any future information or events happening within the township.

If streets cannot be cleared of snow, critical services like the Fire Department and Ambulance would not be able to access the streets when they are needed during an emergency response and the Township's number one priority is the safety of all residents at all times of the year.
