Your road will be posted 48 hours in advance of the resurfacing of your street. To make the day easier for your family and to minimize damage to your vehicles and to the new road surface, we suggest the following:

After 6am, at some time throughout that day, your roadway will be closed to vehicular traffic until the road surface is cured and ready for traffic. The amount of time required for a road closure is determined by climate and weather conditions, mechanical and material circumstances, and the type of resurfacing process planned for the roadway. In general, road closures may be from approximately 30 minutes up to approximately 5 hours. **Anticipated road closures of more than 3 hours are denoted with an asterisk (*) next to the road name. A little planning on your part will make your day a little easier.**

- 1) Park your car in a place and manner that allows for an easy drive away that morning. Try to park in a place so you do not have to cross the street to get to your car.
- 2) Notify all lawn care (turn off sprinklers), contractors, cleaning and delivery people, homecare providers, child and pet sitters that your road will be closed at some time.
- 3) Notify any handicap or elderly transport services that your road will be closed at some time.
- 4) Know that your mail and parcel delivery services may be interrupted from normal delivery schedules.
- 5) Barring any problems, all roads in your neighborhood should be reopened before approximately 6:00 p.m.

Note: The Township notifies the affected school bus company, postal service, emergency services and trash collection.
